

GENERAL INFORMATION

LOCATION: Sedalia, Missouri, is located on U.S. Highway 65 and U.S. 50, 18 miles South of Interstate 70 which runs between Kansas City and St. Louis.

SHEEP & SWINE PAVILION: The shows and sales will be held on the Missouri State Fairgrounds which is situated on U.S. 65, slightly South and West in the city of Sedalia. Sheep will be penned, shown and sold in both the Sheep and Swine Pavilions.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

TERMS: Cash on Sale Day, Canadian and Mexican buyers must pay in U.S. funds. A 10% surcharge will be assessed to any insufficient funds checks issued. The Auctioneer's decision will be final on any dispute as to bids. Substitute entries will be designated with a bar under the lot number. All animals are at purchaser's risk as soon as sold.

REGISTRATIONS: All Sheep and Boer Goats, except Crossbred Wether Sires & Dams and Club Lambs, are registered and will be transferred to purchasers at the consignor's expense.

SHIPPING: Each consignor will be responsible for shipping arrangements of sheep purchased on order. Shipping can be arranged by the sale manager by truck to most all sections of the country at very nominal cost if notified in advance of the sale.

SPECIAL HEALTH REQUESTS: All sheep consigned to this show and sale must be accompanied by an official health certificate with the following information written on the certificate:

- 1) The sheep and flock of origin were examined 30 days prior to movement and found to be free of contagious or infectious diseases and exposures thereto.
- 2) Breeding rams were individually examined and found free of gross lesions or ram epididymitis. All Yearling Rams and Fall Ram Lambs must have a negative B-Ovis Elisa test for ram epididymitis.
- 3) Please have an official health certificate for EACH BREED you are consigning. (Do not have two or three breeds on same health paper).

SALE HEADQUARTERS: The Ramada Inn, located near the northwest corner of the state fairgrounds on Highway 50 West and the State Fair Motor Inn on US 65 will be the sale headquarters motels.

MOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS: The Sedalia Chamber of Commerce is maintaining a list of rooms, both motel and private, and their availability in and around Sedalia. They can be reached at 800/827-5295 or at 660/826-2222.

AIR SERVICE: Sedalia is located about two and one-half hours from Kansas City International Airport, which is served by most major airlines. Most major car rental agencies are available; advanced reservations advised.

SALE GUARANTEE

EXCEPT FOR THOSE STATED IN THE BELOW GUARANTEE, THERE ARE NO WARRANTIES, EITHER EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED, AS TO THE MERCHANT ABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE WITH RESPECT TO THE SHEEP BEING SOLD IN THIS SALE.

THE WARRANTIES AND GUARANTEES SET FORTH IN THE BELOW GUARANTEE ARE IN LIEU OF ALL OTHER WARRANTIES, EITHER EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED, AND THE REMEDIES PROVIDED THEREIN SHALL BE THE SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE REMEDY OF THE BUYER, OR ANY PARTY CLAIMING THROUGH THE BUYER, FOR ANY BREACH OF WARRANTY OR GUARANTEE THEREIN PROVIDED, AND ALL OTHER OBLIGATIONS OR LIABILITIES.

- 1) Every ram and ewe sold will be guaranteed as a breeder if properly handled. It shall be the responsibility of the buyer to return a non-breeder to the seller in acceptable breeding condition. The seller, after a fair trial and the animal is found to be a non-breeder, shall have the privilege of replacing the ram or ewe with one of equal value to the satisfaction of the buyer and seller, or refunding the purchase price. This guarantee shall not apply to any sheep that are shown subsequent to the date of the sale, for the year shown.
- 2) Notification of non-breeder rams or bucks must be made to the seller prior to January 1 following the sale; notification of non-breeder ewes or does must be made to the seller prior to April 1 following the sale.
- 3) Any lambs that drop their lambs teeth prior to 12 months of age as determined by their registration papers, shall be replaced with a lamb of equal quality to the satisfaction of the buyer and seller within a reasonable amount of time, or the consignor shall refund the purchase price of the lamb promptly with all fees and percentages levied against such a lamb retained by the sale. It shall be the responsibility of the buyer to notify the consignor, and then the sale manager, if such a problem occurs. Any consignor failing to comply with this rule shall automatically be barred from consigning any sheep to the following Midwest Stud Ram Sale.
- 4) Neither the Sale Managers nor the sponsoring organization can or will assume any responsibility as to the authenticity of the pedigrees or bloodline information provided in the sale catalog, on pen cards, or otherwise, and the subsequent genetic performance of any sheep purchased. All such information must be accepted at face value. Any special guarantees or claims offered by individual consignors is strictly between the consignor and buyer, and will not be enforced by the Sale Managers or the sponsoring organization, Missouri Sheep Producers.
- 5) This guarantee shall constitute a contract between the buyer and the seller only, and no other parties assume any liability, legal or otherwise, expressed or implied.

ATTENTION BUYERS: SPECIAL HEALTH PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

U.S. BUYERS: Your local or state veterinarian should be able to update you concerning any special regulations concerning the health requirements for sheep entering your state. The Sale Veterinarian will prepare standard, interstate health papers for transportation between states, but it is the buyer's responsibility to be cognizant of and adhere to the entrance requirements for his own state. While entry permits can be obtained from your state office from Sedalia, this can often be done prior to your arrival at the sale.

CANADIAN BUYERS: Please contact a federal veterinarian for a detailed list of requirements for importation of sheep into Canada.

MEXICAN BUYERS: Please contact a federal veterinarian for a detailed list of requirements for importation of sheep into Canada.

MAIL BID SERVICES: Those buyers unable to attend the sale who wish to buy sheep on "Mail Bid" or "Phone Bid" may do so by contacting the person of their choice associated with the sale. Among those able to assist in this regard are the judges, the auctioneers, the ringmen, the consignors or any of the individuals pictured in the forward section of this catalog. Contact them in advance of the sale at their homes or during the week prior to the sale at the phone numbers listed.

DELIVERY SERVICES: Normal delivery services of sheep purchased in the sale can be made to most any section of the country for nominal cost if notified in advance. Contact the sale managers for assistance in this regard and they will do their best to handle your request.

CANADIAN OR MEXICAN EXPORT: Canadian and Mexican buyers will have to be familiar with their own health requirements for entry of sheep purchased in this sale to their country. Canadian buyers will have to make arrangements to have any sheep purchased tested for Blue Tongue and Brucella Ovis. Costs for Federal Health Papers, any tests beyond the normal sale tests and shipping and arrangements will be at the buyer's expense. The sale managers will provide assistance as best they can upon request.
